Cradle of Humankind Tour

Pick up:

Guests will be picked up from the Sandton Convention Centre (pick up time - 08:45). From Johannesburg they will travel to the Cradle of Humankind World Heritage site where they will visit the Lesedi Cultural Village and the Rhino and Lion Nature Reserve.



Lesedi African Experience

Highlights of this interactive tour include: multilingual, audio-visual orientation depicting the history of South Africa; guided tour through traditional homesteads of Zulu, Xhosa, Pedi and Sotho villages; ending with a song and dance performance.



Lunch:

Afterwards guests will enjoy lunch at Roots Restaurant situated in the Cradle of Humankind.

Roots Gourmet Restaurant is renowned as one of Johannesburg's top fine dining restaurants. Indulge in delectable dishes inspired by French, African and Asian influences. Head Chef Allistaire and his team create new menus daily. The cellar boasts wines handpicked from top South African wine estates. Lunches are highly popular at this fine establishment. Sharing exquisite food inside Roots, or al fresco on the sun deck, with views over the lake and the veld, must be one of the most delightful things one can do.



Rhino and Lion Nature Reserve:

After lunch guests will continue to the Rhino and Lion Nature Reserve.

The Rhino & Lion Nature Reserve is a privately owned, non-subsidized game reserve, covering approximately 1 200 hectares on the typical Highveld of Gauteng. The reserve, founded in 1985, is situated in the "Cradle of Humankind", a declared World Heritage Site, about 40km North-West of Johannesburg and 60km West of Pretoria. The reserve had a modest beginning of only 2 White Rhino. The reserve now features over 600 head of game and up to 30 species of wildlife.

Enquiries / Information

Due to the rare and dangerous species having a greater attraction value: Lion, Cheetah and later, the highly endangered Cape Wild Dog were introduced. By moving in the rare species, a breeding programme was initiated which led to further programmes for Bengal Tigers, Siberian Tigers and the very rare White Lion.

Return:

Afterwards guests will be transferred back to the Sandton Convention Centre in Johannesburg (drop off time – 17:30).
